Manifest on First May 2011

Programmatic struggle, organized and unified

In the context of the present economic crisis, the class struggle in the world is expressed in an unequal, characterized by increasing capital accumulation and unsystematic response of the working class. Everywhere, the problems are the same but, in general, it lacks a program that would unify to all workers and peoples.

Attack the causes not only the effects

The capitalist crisis, in its multiple facets: financial, energetic, political, social and cultural, is caused by the same economic and political system imperialist, paid by workers and peoples, for the enhancement of capital accumulation, the overexploitation of the work live and the increase in private gain.

The working response remains uneven, disorganized, and superficial. It is clear that responses must be provided to the immediate objectives. For workers the situation is on survival, given the systematic reduction in their conditions of life that affects thousands of millions in the world.

But we cannot fight only against the effects of the crisis. It is pertinent move forward brandishing a common program at international level. In some parts, the working struggle is admirable but in other, it is regrettable. Continue lacking core references, which exceed the simple aspiration ethics and enable us to build a unified force and coordinated.

Brutality of the class struggle

Reduction and loss of rights, looting and private appropriation of natural resources, disqualification of labor, escalation of exploitation of the salaried job, increase of the reservation and waste armies, privatization of the patrimony of peoples, and imposition of political economic by the way of supposedly legal reformatations, or, by means of the aggression war, these are characteristics of the crisis.

All secular problems, of lack of worthy work, education, health, housing, social security and access to culture, are increased by considering energy, water and public services as merchandise, joined to repression and violence exercised by the States and its coercion bodies.

The intention of the capital is the historical annihilation of its contrary one. But capitalism cannot work without the natural force represented by the human work. Nevertheless, the imperialistic corporations don't cease of attempting against the life, the environment and nature itself.

In Fukushima, Japan, consequence of the nuclear accident affects at least to six reactors, an extreme situation of the class struggle is revealed. Without labor, union or social rights, the workers are forced by corporations and their contractors to work under suicides conditions, without due protection against nuclear radiations and taking a risk their own life and of next generations, to save to the capital. The enormous social force of these workers doesn't belong together with its political, practically null force. But the capital cannot do without of the workers neither it can substitute them for robots.

The energy is the kernel of the economy in all countries. The private appropriation of the energy sources is part of the class struggle. Voracity of the imperialism doesn't know frontiers and its pretense consists on taking possession of the natural resources where be able and for any means, included the war.

The military interventions of the imperialism in Iraq, Afghanistan and, recently, in Libya have multiple objectives, among other, to make a relatively sure supply of energy primary, as well as, to subject under the aegis from the NATO to nations of those regions.

In Mexico, the offensive of the capital is expressed in diverse planes. The privatization of the energy has taken to the denationalization of the industries of hydrocarbons, electric power, and all energy sources. To the above-mentioned, adds the provoked state of war for the current government whose victims ascend to more than 40 thousand, including civil population and children. Also, is included degradation of labor by application of a repressive policy.

Unity by means organizing and knowledge

There is not any capitalist exit to the crisis benefits to the world. To this crisis another will come with worse consequences. Then, it is necessary to organize the fight to change the model. For it, will be necessary go through a

hard and difficult course we should define collectively.

The fundamental references should be expressed in a fight's common program. The workers of the world should formulate the applicable and necessary strategic and tactical paths everywhere. Essentially, the capital doesn't have homeland, the working class neither has homeland. The imperialism's policies are global; labor reply should be of the same scale.

Oneself politics, a single program, a single organization, an alone one to collective action, they are necessary questions. This outlines the urgency of a new trade unionism that, leaving of the accumulated experience, many times it makes bitter, project revitalized proposals, new organizing forms to international level, and true leaderships that overcome to expired bureaucracies continue dominating in many parts of the orb.

Joined to the above-mentioned, it is vital to develop the struggle in the space of the knowledge, to interior of the working centers, disputing the power to the capital, in the duality of the workers, as salaried and as producers. We need to implant and to generalize the working control of production so that the working processes are guided to satisfaction of human necessities.

In this way, it is crucial to practice the international solidarity, which should be expressed in coordinated actions by continents and regions. Under current conditions, it is not enough the local mobilization, neither the fight only for union recoveries. Without ignoring these, it is necessary to combine programmatic actions.

This 1st May 2011, everywhere the workers we will be present in all possible spaces, amid the capital's war against proletariat. The FTE of Mexico calls to workers of the world to meditate in depth on the political tasks of our time the best way to materialize them successfully.
